Descriptions of Briefing Topics

Attribute Based Access Control (ABAC) , Global Force Management Data Initiative and Enterprise Email (DEE)

ABAC allows an application or system to make real time access/deny decisions by reconciling a user's attributes through a rule set to determine if the person can 'see' the requested information. DMDC, working with DoD CIO and DISA, has implemented an ABAC solution on both the SIPRnet and NIPRnet. DMDC is the authoritative source for DoD identity attributes. It supplies these user identity attributes to the policy (rule set). The allow/deny access decisions occur real time with sub-second response times.

DEE is a DoD CIO, DISA(ESD) endeavor to create an overarching Enterprise/DoD active directory, Global Address List and DoD White pages. Users who migrate to DEE will have an email box based on their persona. A persona describes your affiliation to the DoD, e.g. the same person who is both a reservist and a civilian. You would have two separate email boxes, one for your reserve duties and one for your civilian job. DMDC supplies the Enterprise DEE with information on all CAC holders and supports the maintenance of the contact information (GAL and White Pages) information through the DMDC portal Mil Connect.

Defense Casualty Analysis System (DCAS)

This is a briefing and live demonstration of the DCAS Website 2.0. DCAS 2.0 replaces the previous casualty website which was restricted to DoD use only. Customers can pull both statistics and rosters associated with the Global War on Terror or by individual Operation as well as look into historical summaries and statistics of past operations.

DMDC Data Holdings/How to request the data

Briefing and information on the DMDC Data Request System (DRS) and Information Delivery System (IDS) websites. These websites can be used by DoD customers to request standard and ad-hoc data reports based on DMDC's DoD personnel-related data holdings. In addition, we will show you changes that are being implemented to better serve you. This briefing also provides a short overview of DMDC's most commonly requested files and databases.

DMDCID and SSN Reduction

This briefing provides information related to DMDC's efforts in protecting the privacy of Service members and anyone affiliated with the DoD. Removal of the SSN from all DoD Identification cards is an effort designed to reduce the risk of identity theft while maintaining continuity of DoD business processes.

DMDC Survey Program 101

Overview of the DMDC Survey Program, to include services, products, methodologies, and technology used to fulfill this mission.

DSO Events and Real-life Stories

This briefing provides an overview of the Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC) Support Office (DSO)—a beneficiary call center, field support helpdesk for representatives at military identification card issuance facilities (RAPIDS sites) and other offices, and a research and analysis section that collectively respond to well over one million calls and cases per year. DSO provides the human interface between the beneficiary, a multitude of government agencies, end-users of DoD personnel and medical systems, and the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) database. This briefing explores the types of issues with which DSO assists as well as ongoing efforts to achieve exemplary customer service and improve data quality.

Future Role of the Reserve Component

A summary of survey results and significant findings within the data for Reserve component members overall, by component, by rank, and by Reserve program. The January 2012 Status of Forces Survey of Reserve Component Members (SOFS-R) was requested by the Office of Assistant Secretary of Defense (Reserve Affairs) (OASD(RA)) to assess Guard and Reserve member opinions on retention, effects of activations/deployments, and future activations. Metrics were collected in response to recommendations put forth in the "Comprehensive Review of the Future Role of the Reserve Component" report prepared by the Office of the Vice Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and OASD(RA), dated 5 April 2011.

Military Survey Response Rate Trends

Briefing on recent trends in response rates to military surveys, new methods to tailor contact methods to military subgroups (e.g., Army E1-E4).

Person Data Environment (PDE)

Introduction to a collaborative research environment for performing data analyses and studies. The PDE encourages collaboration among researchers and the Department of Defense. It brings the analyst to the data rather than the data to the analyst.

Portal and E-correspondence

Overview of what users can see and do in the milConnect portal. In addition, you will receive an update on how DMDC is leveraging milConnect to provide electronic correspondence to DoD beneficiaries.

Spouse and Family Life Longitudinal Research and Studies

Briefing showing the results of recent research of family and spouse data collected via DMDC's Survey Program, to include longitudinal and trend analysis conducted to support policy office program evaluation.

Transition Assistance

DMDC is working with the Transition to Veteran's Program Office (TVPO) to build applications for use by Servicemembers and their spouses, to collect official data via a variety of interfaces, and to maintain a data repository to enable statistical reporting to the Office of Secretary of Defense and the Military Services. The main application will centralize information from the Services, the Departments of Labor, Veterans Affairs, and Education, the Office of Personnel Management, and the Small Business Association. This information will be available to the Servicemember so he/she can learn about transition services and benefits, connect or obtain transition-related DD Forms, complete required forms, verify benefits, etc.
