MEMORANDUM FOR Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC) Common Access Card Personal Identification Number Reset, Work Station (CPR-WS) Users

SUBJECT: CPR-WS Authority to Operate

Ref:

- (a) CPR-WS System Security Authorization Agreement (SSAA) dated November 19, 2004
- (b) Certification Authority Recommendation Memorandum dated January 12, 2005
- (c) Department of Defense Instruction (DODI) 5200.40, Defense Information Technology Security Certification and Accreditation Process (DITSCAP), December 1997
- (d) DITSCAP Application Manual 8510.1-M, December 1999

Having reviewed reference(a) and (b), and in accordance with reference (c) and (d), I have determined that the operation of DMDC CPR-WS as defined in reference (a) is within the bounds of acceptable risk. Therefore, an Authority to Operate (ATO) is granted for a period of three years from the date of this memorandum.

A complete certification and accreditation, in accordance with reference (c) and (d), will be conducted on the CPR-WS prior to the expiration of this Accreditation, if there is a significant change to the utilization, deployment, and/or design and configuration of the system.
